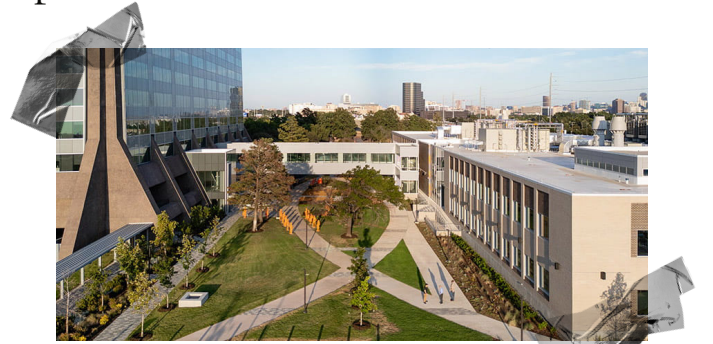


## WHAT IS BIOFORCE?

BioFORCE is a week-long STEM summer program at the University of Texas at Arlington in partnership with the National Center for Therapeutics (NCTM), part of the Texas A&M Engineering Experiment Station, which introduces high school students in our region to the rapidly evolving biomanufacturing industry. BioFORCE is designed to ignite a passion for the biological sciences and encourage students to consider a career in this underrepresented industry.

## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- Lectures and Labs: Build upon high school biology and chemistry concepts, highlighting the process of translating medical research into new drugs and treatments.
- Tour of Biotechnology Facility: Experience cutting-edge technology.
- Hands-On Activities: Engage in cleanroom gowning, liquid chromatography, and bacterial transformation.
- Students who complete the camp will receive an official Credly digital badge, which can be shared on LinkedIn, resumes, and digital portfolios.
